Bowral Honey Farm offers unique agritourism experiences where visitors can learn about bees and their vital role in agriculture and the environment. Our working honey farm is located in the beautiful Southern Highlands of NSW, renowned for its lush farmlands, pristine bush, rivers, waterfalls, and pure, clean air.

Our teaching facility is a meticulously restored and updated rustic farm building with a vine covered trellis over an outdoor terrace. The view to the hives which sit alongside an ornamental lake, and beyond to the rolling hills is magnificent.

Our experiences range from a simple one hour tour through to fully immersive opportunities for those with a little more time and budget.

All of the visits include a tour of the apiary, a beekeeping talk and guided honey tasting, complemented by a full morning tea of tea and coffee and freshly baked sourdough bread.

Every weekend, our shop is open for free tastings of four honey varieties, available for purchase. No booking required.

We are on the grounds of a beautiful historic property where guests can also book a tour of the magnificent Italianate mansion or visit a brand new regional gallery for a free self directed visit.

Our agritourism tours offer the perfect blend of education, adventure, and food tourism, led by an enthusiastic and passionate beekeeper with over 40 years of experience. Expect great photo opportunities and incredible honey.

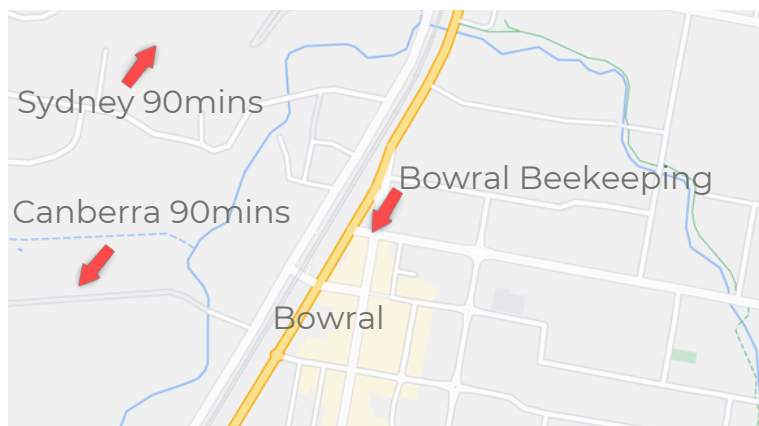

ULTIMATE BEEKEEPING EXPERIENCE

This three-hour experience immerses guests in the world of bees, beekeeping, and honey, set on a historic property overlooking a private lake and rolling hills. The visit includes an educational talk, a guided apiary tour, hands-on hive activities, and a honey tasting with morning tea.

Guests put on full-length sting-proof suits for a guided tour with Hamish, the founder and head beekeeper. They open a hive, observe the colony up close, and remove a frame of capped honey. Back at the teaching area, they extract honey using an ancient cold-press method and take home a jar of freshly harvested honey, still warm from the hive.

A standout moment is the chance to safely hold a "handful of bees." Under Hamish's guidance, guests (wearing gloves) feel the bees vibrate as they communicate—an incredible sensory experience. With hands-on activities, great photo opportunities, and exceptional honey to take home, this is a truly unforgettable encounter with the world of bees.

AIR BEE N BEE - HONEY & HIVE

This two-hour experience immerses guests in the world of bees, with rolling hills and a private lake as the backdrop. It begins on a scenic terrace with a guided honey tasting, where guests sample up to six floral-source honeys, each reflecting the seasonal blooms surrounding the honey farm.

Over morning tea—fresh sourdough with plunger coffee or loose-leaf tea—guests learn about the intricate lifecycle of bees, their social structure, and their vital role in food production and biodiversity.

The experience continues in the apiary, where guests suit up in full beekeeping gear and light a smoker before opening a hive. Under expert guidance, they hold a frame of bees, observe the queen, and witness the hive's mesmerizing organization up close.

With hands-on learning, unique photo opportunities, and a deeper appreciation for these vital pollinators, this experience offers an unforgettable glimpse into the fascinating world of bees.

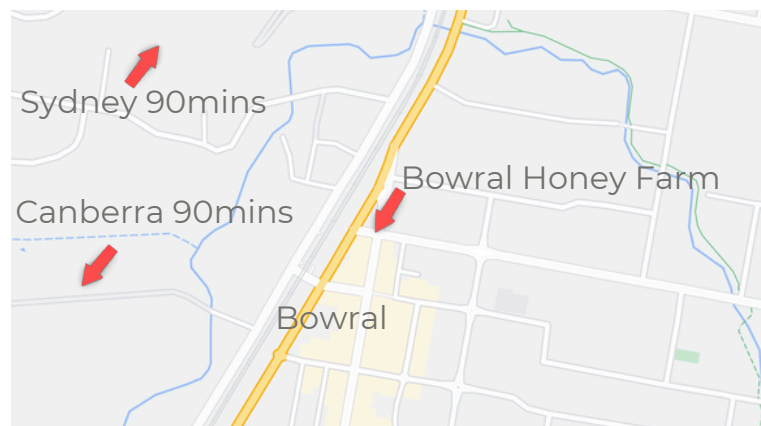

TOUR - TALK - HONEY TASTING

This one-hour beekeeping experience offers an engaging introduction to bees, their behaviors, and their vital role in the ecosystem. Guests begin with a guided tour alongside the hives, wearing protective head veils as they safely observe the colony in action. They learn about the bees' lifecycle, social structure, and honey production, followed by a history of beekeeping and a demonstration of a modern hive, showcasing contemporary techniques and the challenges facing these at-risk pollinators.

The experience continues on a scenic terrace overlooking the dam and rolling hills, where guests enjoy a guided honey tasting. Sampling six floral-source honeys, they explore the distinct flavors, aromas, and textures shaped by seasonal blooms.

The visit concludes with a relaxed morning tea of freshly baked sourdough, served with loose-leaf tea or plunger coffee—offering a perfect blend of education, flavor, and scenic beauty.
