



About Amaroo


Welcome to the newest luxury retreat in the Byron Bay hinterland: Amaroo Bangalow, Northern NSW, is now open for business. This serene and majestic property is a sophisticated holiday haven with a difference: Amaroo is centred on nature and giving back to the environment. As well as a luxurious escape, the owners have built a place of regeneration, growth and sustainability. This is a space of quiet luxury to connect with land and with each other.

Amaroo is immersed in nature, framed by heavenly gardens, dewy rainforests and emerald views at every turn. On arrival, you meander through a country laneway before arriving at an architecturally designed estate that blends seamlessly with the land. Step inside, and you're surrounded by elegant interiors centred on earthy tones and buildings of the highest quality. Expect a beautifully designed country escape to exhale, soak in the beauty of nature and recharge. It is just 10 minutes from Byron coast, but a world away from urban living.

Making Amaroo even more special: the property is also a working cattle farm. So your only neighbours will be cows grazing the fields, freerange chickens roaming the country gardens, and rainbow-coloured native birds. Amaroo also offers supreme exclusivity and privacy. The property was designed with space and tranquillity in mind. It comprises 4 architecturally designed studios that stand alone and 1 central lounge pavilion for sharing with a gourmet kitchen, dining spaces, outdoor decks and a sparkling, emerald-green pool. Whether you are seeking a couples retreat, group getaway for all the family or catch-up with friends, your own piece of paradise awaits.

Key Facts

- The vision for Amaroo began as far back as 2016 when soon-to-be owners Mike and Cathy Tomkins took one look at this majestic property and fell in love with this breathtaking land on top of the Bangalow ridge.
- The property had originally been used for grazing for four generations of farmers but was sold and left uncultivated, so it was in desperate need of care. But Mike and Cathy had a dream: they wanted to restore the land and open it up for others to treasure. • They saw themselves as stewards of the property, responsible for restoring its ecological balance.
- But little did they know how much work was head. They spent 6 years regenerating the land and planting thousands of trees.
- Once regeneration was underway, they set about building an architecturally designed estate that would tread lightly on the planet, but cater to large groups of guests seeking a luxury stay immersed in nature, so others could enjoy this idlylic place. • Amaroo finally welcomed its first guests formally in September 2024.
- In 2025, the owners are thrilled to open for their first full year as a luxury holiday stay.

- Amaroo comprises 4 architecturally designed studios (3 cabins and 1 stand alone loft), and a central, shared pavilion which includes a • The holiday stay is spread across 213 acres, offering endless country gardens, bubbling creeks and hidden nooks to wander. • Mike and Cathy were also passionate about honouring the land's farming history. Today, Amaroo is also a working cattle farm with 80 head of Black Angus cattle.
- The property also farms eggs from free-range chickens that roam the gardens, and the owners will soon harvest honey with beehives in the eastern paddock to produce honey by spring 2025.
- Guests can play a part in all that Amaroo offers, from experiencing the pastoral cattle life to the flourishing native flora, collecting eggs and, one day soon collecting honey from the beehive.



- Amaroo Bangalow has been meticulously designed and constructed with sustainability as its core focus. • The vision was born from a simple philosophy of adding, not taking from nature
- of thousands of native plants and trees. This, in turn, is attracting native wildlife and creating a more balanced ecosystem.
- The owners see themselves as caretakers of the land. They worked with local partners to eliminate invasive plants and reintroduce tens • Mike estimates they have planted around 45,000 trees in 6 years, including natives such as Grevilleas, Eucalyptus & Bankisias • Operating at 100% water and 70% energy independence, Amaroo harnesses the power of the sun and relies on the area's abundant rainfall and naturally fed spring creeks
- The accommodations are crafted from natural, sustainable materials, enhancing the immersive experience of the surrounding environment
- thrive. They are also working with East Coast Bush Regeneration (Rossco Faithful), who has assisted Mike and Cathy to guide the development of the land for generations to come
- Thanks to years of hard work by its passionate owners, the property is now flourishing again with native vegetation and wildlife • On the property, you will find Koalas, Wallabies, Black Cockatoos, Platypus, Water Dragons and an abundance of native birds • Mike and Cathy have also teamed up with Bangalow Koalas (Linda Sparrow), and together they are planting more trees for koalas to
